

WSBC 2020 Things to Know

GROCERY SHUTTLES will run on Tuesday, April 21. Please refer to the Conference agenda for times and locations. **YOU MUST RSVP** for the grocery shuttle. Please contact Jeanette Romero at 505-891-2664 or jromero@oa.org to reserve your spot.

DINNER SHUTTLES will run from Tuesday, April 21 through Friday, April 24. Please refer to the Conference agenda for times. The shuttles are open to everyone and **DO NOT** require a reservation. A list of restaurants for Old Town (Tuesday – Friday) and ABQ Uptown (Friday only) will be available at the Visitor’s table near the OA registration desk.

A LUNCH SHUTTLE will run on Saturday, April 25 from 11:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. from the hotel to Old Town. The shuttles are open to everyone and **DO NOT** require a reservation.

LUNCH BUFFET vouchers must be purchased in Caffaina’s at the Embassy Suites to partake in the lunch buffet. Caffaina’s will begin selling vouchers on Tuesday, April 21. The lunch buffet will be from Wednesday, April 22 to Friday, April 24. Individual vouchers can be purchased for US\$16 (includes buffet, beverage, tax, and gratuity) or a 3-day voucher can be purchased for a discount at US\$45 (includes buffet, beverage, tax, and gratuity). The 3-day voucher must be purchased by Wednesday, April 22 at 10 a.m. **Note: The lunch buffet is not available on Saturday, April 25. The hotel may offer a limited restaurant menu. Please refer to the lunch shuttles paragraph above.**
