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


Asking Questions



# Asking Questions:

- ▶ Go to the Center Microphone Monitor (CMM) before approaching the center microphone.
  - ▶ All questions are directed to the chair unless it is time for:
    - ▶ Trustee Reports
    - ▶ Trustee Nominees
  - ▶ Give your name, where you are from, and the name of the service body you represent.
  - ▶ Ask one question and wait at the microphone until you receive an answer.
  - ▶ If the answer is unclear, you may ask for clarification.
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# Asking Questions:

- ▶ Each delegate is permitted to ask one question per report or motion.
    - ▶ If you have a second question, you must return to the back of the line. It will be addressed only if there is time remaining.
  - ▶ There is no debate from the center microphone.
    - ▶ Speaking pro ("I love this.") or con ("I disagree with this.") is considered debate.
  - ▶ Return to your seat.
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# You may ask:

- ▶ Question of Privilege:

- ▶ Ask for something that affects the comfort of a member or the group.
  - ▶ Too much noise, cannot hear
  - ▶ Cannot read the screen
  - ▶ Too warm or too cold
  - ▶ Someone is being disruptive.
  - ▶ For the Serenity Prayer

# You may ask:

- ▶ Request for Information:
  - ▶ Ask for more details
    - ▶ How much will it cost?
    - ▶ How long will it take?
    - ▶ What has happened before?
    - ▶ What will happen if...?

# You may ask:

- ▶ **Parliamentary Inquiry:**
    - ▶ Ask when you are not sure the rules are being followed.
  - ▶ **Point of Order:**
    - ▶ Alert the chair if the rules are not being followed.
  - ▶ **Suspend the Rules:**
    - ▶ Ask to do something different from the Standing Rules.
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
