OA-Approved Literature List

■ Statement on Approved Literature (2012 World Service Business Conference)

“In accordance with our Traditions, we suggest that OA groups maintain unity and honor our Traditions by using, selling and displaying only approved books and pamphlets at their meetings. This includes OA Conference- and board-approved literature; AA Conference-approved books, and all future editions thereof, with original edition copyright 2010 or earlier; and locally produced OA literature. Locally produced literature must be developed according to the OA Guidelines for Locally Produced Literature, and should be used with the greatest discretion. Local literature should be considered temporary and discontinued when OA literature approved for general use is available to cover the topic.”

■ Statement on Literature That Is Not OA-Approved (1993 World Service Business Conference)

“It is the group conscience of the 1993 World Service Business Conference that the sale or display of literature other than OA-approved literature as described in WSBC Policy 1982b [replaced by 2012 Statement on Approved Literature above] is an implied endorsement of outside enterprises, and therefore is in violation with Tradition Six.”
